## POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

One of our main goals is to provide a pleasant, clean, comfortable and satisfying dining experience. In order to meet this goal, we ask for your assistance with the following policies:

- Please clear your dishes, cups, and utensils when you have finished dining.
- Refrain from taking dishes or utensils from the dining area.
- Remember that meal cards are non-transferable and cannot be used by anyone but the card owner.
- Munch Money, Dining Dollars, Cave Cash, credit cards, debit cards, and cash can be used at any GGC dining facility.
- Meal plan meals can be used only at the Student Center Dining Hall.
- Changes to your selected meal plan may only be made within two days from the start of classes each semester.

## MEAL CARDS

As your official identification card, the Claw Card gives you access to campus dining facilities and services, and allows you to make purchases at any of our dining locations. Get your Claw Card at the Claw Card office.

## RESIDENT MEAL PLANS

All resident students are required to participate in a meal plan. The following meal plans are available for the 2011-2012 academic year. Meal Plan costs are per academic semester:

### Resident Meal Plan Options

*(Meals per week or semester refers to meals eaten in the dining hall)*

Plan	# of Meals	Munch Money	Cost
<b>A</b>	Unlimited	\$100.00	\$1290.30
<b>B</b>	14 /week	\$250.00	\$1290.30
<b>C</b>	7 /week	\$375.00	\$1290.30
<b>D</b>	85/semester	\$525.00	\$1290.30

Any unused Munch Money funds (money attached to your meal plan) will roll over from fall semester to spring semester. Any remaining Munch Money funds, up to \$100.00 at the end of spring semester, will roll over for use during both summer school sessions. All remaining Munch Money Funds on your account expire the last day of the second session of summer semester finals.

By default, all residential students are signed up for Plan A. Students have until the second day of classes at the beginning of each semester to make any changes to their meal plans.

To purchase a meal plan, simply go to the Student Accounts office in Building D.

## COMMUTER MEAL PLANS

All first year commuter students at Georgia Gwinnett College are required to purchase a commuter meal plan.

<b>E</b>	60	\$ 50.00	\$428.00
<b>F</b>	30	\$100.00	\$285.00
<b>G</b>	15	\$100.00	\$215.00
<b>H</b>	0	\$200.00	\$215.00

By default, all first year full-time commuter students are signed up for Plan G. By default, all first year part-time commuter students are signed for Plan H. Students have until the second day of classes at the beginning of each semester to make any changes to their meal plans.

## VOLUNTARY DINING DOLLARS

Parents and students have the option to add Voluntary Dining Dollars to supplement their existing meal plan Munch Money funds. Voluntary Dining Dollars can be used to purchase food at any GGC dining facility on campus, or to bring guests into the Student Center Dining Hall.

The advantage of purchasing Voluntary Dining Dollars is that students do not have to carry cash to purchase food, and parents also have some control over how the money is spent since purchases are limited to food. Additionally, Dining Dollar purchases are considered part of the meal plan and, therefore, are not subject to sales tax.

There are two ways to add money to your Claw Card Account.

- Visit Student Accounts, located in Building D, room 1147. Payments in cash and/or by credit card are accepted.
- Use the PHIL Machine located in the B-Building atrium. Just deposit cash to add dining dollars to your card.
